2022-2023 MASSGrant

FAFSA Deadline Date: July 1, 2021 (extended from May 1)

How to Apply

Students must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the Federal Central Processor by the appropriate deadline. You can obtain a FAFSA from a high school guidance office, the local library, your college's Financial Aid Office or you can call the DHE's Office of Student Financial Assistance at (617) 391-6070 to request a copy. 2022-2023 Early Childhood Educators Scholarship Program

2022-2023 FAFSA for the 2022-2023 Academic Year

The 2022-2023 FAFSA requires your 2020 Federal Tax return and W-2's. The 2022-2023 FAFSA <u>MUST</u> be completed if you are considering using Federal Student Aid for the 2022-2023 Academic Year. By completing the FAFSA, you may also be eligible for other State Grant programs for the 2022-2023 Academic Year.

COURSE MEETING FORMATS

Full Semester Classes (15 weeks) (FALL ONLY)

Option 1 \rightarrow _Asynchronous Classes – Fully online and remote coursework. Classes are delivered in Brightspace without scheduled meeting times and do not require you to come to campus.

Option $2 \rightarrow Face$ to face – UCB is offering a limited number of in person classes to be held on a specific day of the week and during a set timeframe. Faculty and students on campus and in person must be fully vaccinated.

Fast Track Classes (10 weeks) (SUMMER & FALL)

Asynchronous Remote – All fast-track sections are fully online and asynchronous. Classes will be delivered mostly in Brightspace without any class meeting times and faculty and students will not be required to come to campus.

Hybrid Classes (8 weeks) (SUMMER & FALL)

Hybrid – Class will meet face to face on campus from 6-9 PM on one evening or 9:30-12:30 on Saturday mornings for 8 weeks. The rest of the course will be completed in an asynchronous format, mostly via Brightspace. Faculty and students in on campus, hybrid courses must be fully vaccinated.

STUDENT SERVICES MONTHLY REVIEW OF A STUDENT POLICY

Sexual Assault, Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, or Stalking Policy

The College is obligated to investigate all allegations of sexual violence, even if the alleged victim chooses not to file a formal complaint and/or participate in the investigation. Additionally, a complaint filed in another forum, including a criminal or civil complaint, shall not delay the college's investigation of a complaint of sexual violence. The college shall promptly and thoroughly investigate all such allegations in accordance with the Policy on Affirmative Action's Complaint Procedure and shall provide the victim with periodic updates on the status of the investigation. The following procedures should be followed for any sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, or stalking. For complete policy details, refer to the Student Handbook

Política de la agresión sexual, violencia doméstica, violencia en noviazgo, y el acoso.

La universidad está obligada a investigar todas las acusaciones de la violencia sexual, incluso si la presunta víctima decide en no presentar una queja formal y/o participar en la investigación. Adicionalmente, una queja presentada en otro foro, incluyendo una queja criminal o civil, no debe retrasar la investigación universitaria de alguna queja de violencia sexual. La universidad debe investigar todas las acusaciones inmediatamente y minuciosamente en acuerdo con la Política del Procedimiento de Quejas de La Acción Afirmativa (Affirmative Action). Estas investigaciones deben proveer a la víctima con actualizaciones periódicas del estatus de la investigación. Los siguientes procedimientos se deben seguir para cualquier incidente de agresión sexual, violencia doméstica, violencia en noviazgo, y el acoso. Para más detalles acerca de la política, referirse a la guía estudiantil.



Generation Success Partner Autodesk Launches Microgrants for Students Entering Construction Trades

Last month marked the fifth year of Autodesk's "Make It Real" program that cultivates student interest and builds workforce adaptability, particularly for those entering the construction trades. According to the company, one of the biggest barriers facing young people interested in trade careers is everyday expenses associated with job training, like tools, work clothes and boots, and transportation. To help with such costs, Autodesk announced \$50,000 of flexible microgrants, so that recipients can decide for themselves how to apply the funds where they are needed most. The \$500 individual microgrants are open to graduating high school seniors who are continuing their education in the building trades through apprenticeship programs or two-year vocational schools.






