In keeping with best practices and to maintain maximum flexibility for our faculty and students, most classes in the summer semester will be delivered remotely and without meeting times. This delivery method is sometimes referred to as "asynchronous", which means that faculty deliver content remotely and students do their work with limited or no real-time interactions. Faculty may require students to be online or on the phone at specific times but those should be less frequent and more flexible than a typical course. Five-weekend mini-sessions will continue to be held for a specific timeframe (Friday 6-9, Saturday 9-3). **Additional sections will be added as needed. Sections ending in C are offered in Mandarin. Sections ending in S are offered in Spanish.**
