

# Urban College of Boston Fall 2020 Course Schedule

In keeping with best practices and to maintain maximum flexibility for our faculty and students, all classes in the fall session will be delivered remotely and without meeting times. This delivery method is sometimes referred to as "asynchronous", which means that faculty deliver content remotely and students do their work with limited or no real-time interactions. Five-weekend mini-sessions will continue to be held for a specific timeframe (Friday 6-9, Saturday 9-3). Faculty may require students to be online or on the phone at specific times but those should be less frequent and more flexible than a typical course.
